

CYNTHIA M. A. BUTLER-MCINTYRE NATIONAL PRESIDENT~ DELTA SIGMA THETA SORORITY, INC.

WHEREAS, Cynthia M. A. Butler-McIntyre is the 24th National President of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated, a private, non-profit organization whose purpose is to provide assistance and support through established programs in local communities throughout the world. Founded in 1913 at Howard University, Delta Sigma Theta now includes a membership of more than 200,000 predominately Black, college educated women, with over 900 chapters between undergraduate and graduate levels; and

WHEREAS, President Butler-McIntyre was initiated into the Sorority through the Beta Gamma Chapter of Dillard University on November 30, 1973, completing her Bachelor of Arts degree in early childhood education, and then earning a Master of Education degree in curriculum and instruction/educational administration at the University of New Orleans at the age of 20. She is the recipient of an Honorary Doctorate of Divinity degree in religious education from the Louisiana Christian Bible College and has served Delta Sigma Theta with distinction at the local, state, regional and national levels; and


WHEREAS, President Butler-McIntyre currently serves as a director of human resources for the Jefferson Parish Public School System in Harvey, Louisiana., where he has impacted the lives of countless young people for over 30 years as a teacher, assistant principal, summer school principal and personnel administrator, and has inspired thousands as a motivational, educational and religious speaker; and


WHEREAS, President Butler-McIntyre's distinguished service and outstanding achievements have been recognized by numerous professional, civic and religious organizations on the local, state and national levels. She is an active, life-long member of the Olive Branch Baptist Church in New Orleans, and she serves on several boards including the New Orleans Convention Center, MLK Task Force and The Delta Research and Development Foundation; the National Council of Negro Women, the Louisiana State and American Association of School Personnel Administrators, and Founding President of the Algiers-Gretna Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP).


NOW, THEREFORE, be it known by all and declared by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio that:


