Jenkins has served Bath Township for the past 12 years as a trustee where he was active in the enactment and implementation of the land use Comprehensive Plan for the township encompassing a Natural Resource Study and a set of Design Guidelines, and the formation of a Joint Economic Development District (JEDD) with the cities of Akron and Fairlawn designed to preclude the annexation of township land; and


WHEREAS, Mr. Jenkins was a vital part of the township administration, approving nearly 800 resolutions, more than 15,000 requisitions, participating in more than 40 employee interviews and more than 150 Board of Zoning Appeals meetings in his three four-year terms since 1998; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jenkins is a graduate of Akron's Kenmore High School, and the University of Akron where he completed his Bachelor of Arts degree as an Air Force Reserve Officer training Corps distinguished military graduate; and



He completed the National Security Management Course of the industrial College of the Armed Forces and the executive program in National and International Security at Harvard University and served as Dean and Professor of Law at the University of Akron School of Law, concentrating in the areas of business and banking law.


