

## DYLAN SCHULZ

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the Boy Scouts of America—incorporated on February 8, 1910, and chartered by Congress in 1916—is to provide an educational program for boys and young adults to build character, to train in the responsibilities of participating citizenship, and to develop personal fitness; and

**WHEREAS**, to earn the Eagle Scout rank, the highest advancement rank in Scouting, a Boy Scout must fulfill requirements in the areas of leadership, service, and outdoor skills; and


**WHEREAS**, not every boy who joins a Boy Scout troop earns the Eagle Scout rank; only about 4 percent of all Boy Scouts do so. This represents more than 1 million Boy Scouts who have earned the rank since 1911; and

**WHEREAS**, **Dylan Schulz** successfully completed his Eagle Scout project, which included the replacement of a picket fence at the historic John Brown House. Working with the Summit County Historical Society, Dylan raised more than \$500 for the project and led several scouts in his troop on the task of replacing and staining the 178-foot-long fence, along Copley Road in West Akron; and






