

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-221

**A Resolution deleting the non-bargaining unclassified position of Director of Administration – EXE #29102 from the County's Executive's Pay Plan and approving the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for its replacement, the new non-bargaining, unclassified position of Senior Administrator – EXE #89702, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, County Council has the authority pursuant to Article III, Section 3.03 (10) of the Charter of the County of Summit and Sections 169.08, 169.09, 169.10 and 169.11 of the Codified Ordinances to establish classifications, classification specifications and pay/salary schedules for all County employees; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested pursuant to Sections 169.11 that the non-bargaining unclassified position of Director of Administration – EXE #29102 be deleted from the County Executive's Pay Plan and that the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for its replacement, the new non-bargaining, unclassified position of Senior Administrator – EXE #89702 be approved; and

WHEREAS, at its April 24, 2006 meeting, the Human Resource Commission approved the deletion of Director of Administration–EXE #29102 from the Executive's Pay Plan County's and the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the new non-bargaining unclassified position of Senior Administrator – EXE #89702; and

WHEREAS, the Executive intends to reassign employees currently serving in the classification of Director of Administration – EXE #29102 to the new classification of Senior Administrator – EXE #89702; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that approving the deletion of Director of Administration – EXE #29102 from the Executive's Pay Plan and approving the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for its replacement, the new position of Senior Administrator – EXE #89702 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The following classification is hereby deleted from the County Executive's Pay Plan:

**DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION– EXE #29102 UNCLASSIFIED--existing position in County Executive's Office being replaced.**

SECTION 2

The following classification is hereby approved:

SECTION 2 (Cont.)

**SENIOR ADMINISTRATOR – EXE #89702 UNCLASSIFIED**—new classification, classification specification.

The classification specification for the aforementioned classification, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein as if fully restated, is hereby approved. The aforementioned classification is assigned the salary schedule of CE-9, which is the same salary schedule approved by Amended Resolution No. 2006-069 for Director of Administration – EXE #29102. The classification of Director of Administration – EXE #29102 shall be deleted from the County Executive's Pay Plan upon the reassignment of all employees currently serving in that classification to Senior Administrator – EXE #89702.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and employees of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to approve the deletion of Director of Administration – EXE from the Executive's Pay Plan and the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the new non-bargaining unclassified position of Senior Administrator – EXE.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4



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
