

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-222

DATE June 5, 2006

A Resolution approving the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the non-bargaining, classified position of Assistant Administrator – EXE #29010, for the Executive’s Department of Human Resources and the Human Resource Commission, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, County Council has the authority pursuant to Article III, Section 3.03 (10) of the Charter of the County of Summit and Sections 169.08, 169.09, 169.10 and 169.11 of the Codified Ordinances to establish classifications, classification specifications and pay/salary schedules for all County employees; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has requested pursuant to Sections 169.11 that the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for its replacement, the non-bargaining, unclassified position of Assistant Administrator – EXE #29010 be approved; and

WHEREAS, at its April 24, 2006 meeting, the Human Resource Commission approved the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the aforementioned position, as stated in Amended Order No. 06-03, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that approving the classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the non-bargaining unclassified position of Assistant Administrator – EXE #29010 is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The following classification is hereby approved:

ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR--EXE #29010 CLASSIFIED—new classification, classification specification.

The classification specification for the aforementioned classification, which is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein as if fully restated, is hereby approved. The aforementioned classification is assigned the salary schedule of Category 3, Grade 6, as indicated in Exhibit C, attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and employees of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to approve a new classification, classification specification and salary schedule for the new non-bargaining classified position of Assistant Administrator.

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SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


SECTION 4
