A Resolution adopting the recommendations of the Summit County Methamphetamine Property Awareness Task Force as outlined in the attached Exhibit A, and authorizing the County Executive, Sheriff and County Council to implement said recommendations, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Methamphetamine Property Awareness Task Force was established by Resolution 2008-127 on March 17, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, members of the Summit County Methamphetamine Property Awareness Task Force met several times to determine the most effective way to increase resident awareness of properties that may be contaminated from the drug methamphetamine and may pose a potential threat to their health and safety; and,

WHEREAS, members of the Summit County Methamphetamine Property Awareness Task Force, at its meeting held July 17, 2008, unanimously approved recommendations attached hereto as Exhibit A to be submitted to County Council; and,

WHEREAS, the recommendations necessitate the Sheriff, Executive and County Council collaborate on the implementation of certain measures with regard to informing residents of properties affected by the drug methamphetamine; and,

WHEREAS, the effects of exposure to methamphetamine pose a serious risk to the health, safety and welfare of Summit County citizens and the County's environment, making it necessary to address these increasing risks in a more aggressive, comprehensive and coordinated manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The recommendations of the Summit County Methamphetamine Property Awareness Task Force as outlined in the attached Exhibit A are hereby adopted by County Council and the Sheriff, Executive and County Council are authorized to implement said recommendations.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of implementing the recommendations as soon as possible.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


