A Resolution adjusting appropriations in the amount of \$63,652.39 for the 800MHz Maintenance Fund, for the Executive's Department of Finance and Budget, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit 800MHz Maintenance Fund received \$270,600.00 in funding for the 2008 program year; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust \$63,652.39 of the original appropriations in order to provide effective program services; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the adjusting appropriations in the amount of \$63,652.39 for the 800 MHz Maintenance Fund are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Appropriations are hereby adjusted as follows:
