An Ordinance adjusting the boundaries of Richfield Township to conform to the approved annexation of 32.3079 acres from Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, for the County of Summit Council, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, by passage of Richfield Village Resolution 30-2008, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A", the Village of Richfield has petitioned the County Council pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 503.07 to adjust the boundaries of Richfield Township to conform to the approved annexation of 32.3079 acres from Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, the 32.3079 acres of the approved annexation to be transferred from Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield by this adjustment of the township line are set forth in the description attached as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, following receipt of a petition pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 503.07, the subsequent action by County Council to conform boundaries is a ministerial act to implement the intent of all parties that the annexed land be solely within the municipal boundaries of the Village and no longer part of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" attached hereto are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully rewritten.

SECTION 2

The lines of Richfield Township and the Village of Richfield are hereby made identical in part to the lines of the municipal corporation of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio as set forth in Exhibit "B" attached hereto.

SECTION 3

The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Fiscal Officer- Recording Department, the County Engineer, and the Summit County Board of Elections.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to act in a timely manner on a petition duly filed by a municipal corporation pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 503.07.

SECTION 5

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


SECTION 6
