A Resolution authorizing the appropriation of \$37,900.00 from the collection of administrative enrollment fees from the "Current Real Estate Tax Installment Payment Plan", for 2009, for the Fiscal Office, and declaring an emergency

WHEREAS, as a result of current economic conditions, the number of delinquencies in property taxes and assessments have increased, adversely affecting both property ownership and County revenue; and

WHEREAS, in order to mitigate these negative effects, County Council enacted Resolution No. 2009-050, which enacted Chapter 174 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, which provides for the Real Estate Tax Installment Payment Plan, for a monthly payment plan to assist Summit County property owners with their tax payments; and

WHEREAS, in order to support the County Fiscal Office's operating costs of the installment plan, Section 174.04 of the Codified Ordinances authorizes an administrative enrollment fee, equal to 5% of the total taxes and assessments to be paid under the agreement; and

WHEREAS, administrative enrollment fees have been collected and require appropriation to cover costs; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the appropriation of the revenue from the aforementioned administrative enrollment fee is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Tax Installment Plan Admin Funds are hereby appropriated for 2009 as follows:

SECTION 2

The County Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to effect the within appropriations.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately provide for the necessary appropriation of the administrative enrollment fees.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
