

Summit County Emergency Management Agency Special Projects Grant

Review and Selection Guidelines

The Special Projects Grant applications shall be measured against the following criteria:

1. The product of the grant should be a benefit to the general population, or other population identified, of Summit County; therefore, the most credit should go to the application that serves the greatest amount of its citizens.
2. The product of the grant must fulfill one of the four primary functions of emergency management: mitigation, preparedness, response and/or recovery.
3. Applications submitted by multi-jurisdictional teams that meet the standard criteria of the grant shall receive a greater consideration.
4. Applications that address the priorities established by the Domestic Preparedness Task Force, as attached, shall receive consideration.

It should also be noted that the Emergency Management Executive Committee is not compelled to spend the entire line item in any one grant period and has the authority to modify any award amount.
