The meeting of the Summit County Local Emergency Planning Committee was called to order, at 8:37 a.m. at the Emergency Operations Center, 166 S. High Street, Akron, Ohio, by Chairperson Tucker.

Introductions of those in attendance were made.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

CORRESPONDENCE AND COMMENTS:

Chairperson Tucker reviewed letter from Mel House, Ohio Emergency Management, stating that on November 19, 2010 the Summit County HazMat Team was verified as a Type 1 team. He stated this is a very big honor as there are only three teams in Ohio to receive this Type 1 certification.

Ms. De Rose added that this board did a lot, including equipment purchases, to get the County team to where it is.

Chairperson Tucker stated we received a pay-in for the EHS Reimbursements for \$1,680.00

Mr. Smoot stated we would have normally received \$2,100.00, but the LEPC was required to make a 20% local match this year.

Chairperson Tucker reviewed a letter from Ms. De Rose to the Summit County Fiscal Office detailing the upcoming 2011 budget.

Ms. De Rose replied that the LEPC is by resolution only and Ohio Revised Code (ORC) County Council does not approve our budget. Last year we started submitting a budget to the Fiscal Office so that our account would not always show the insufficient funds error in our internal financial management system

Chairperson Tucker reviewed the letter from Vikki Bunting, Ohio EMA Field Liaison, stating that she recommended a concurrence of the Summit County Emergency Response and Preparedness Plan.

Mr. Smoot stated we would further cover the Summit County Emergency Response and Preparedness Plan under old business.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – November 18, 2010

Ms. Breyer made a motion to approve the November 18, 2010 minutes; Ms. Abell seconded the motion.

Mr. Smoot abstained.

INFORMATION COORDINATOR REPORT

Ms. De Rose stated that Tommy Smoot and Chris Miller would cover the information coordinators report

Mr. Smoot stated that the majority of items would be covered in the old and new business. He stated that we received a reimbursement for our EHS Hazards Analysis and welcomed new members Aixa Bakuhn and Chief Thomas Pozza to the meeting.

Ms. Breyer asked if we had a replacement for the member from the press.

Mr. Smoot stated that Jill Skapin, the Director of the Summit County Communications Department, will be filling that role.

OLD BUSINESS

SPILL REMINDER STICKER OR MAGNET RESOULTION

Mr. Smoot stated \$1,000 was approved to fund stickers or magnets and asked the body if they still wanted to move forward on this project.

Ms. Breyer stated she would contact Mr. Smoot and work with him to complete this project.

Mr. Brown suggested calling the Ohio EPA public information office to find out where they purchased them.

AreaRAE MONITOR RESOLUTION

Mr. Smoot stated this was also approved at the last meeting and we were working with the company to correct a few issues with our current system before purchasing two additional units.

Chairperson Tucker stated the issue is the manufacturer's warranty covering the malfunctioning of the units. He stated we are working with the manufacturer to correct the sensitivity of the photoionization detectors (PID).

Mr. Weaver asked what an AreaRae monitor was.

Chairperson Tucker stated it is a monitor that combines a four gas meter with radiation as well as a PID with radio satellite communications. He stated you can monitor a large venue remotely and get real time information about what is taking place.

Mr. Smoot added that Ms. Cindy DeWolf, SERC Administration and Funding Committee, approved the LEPC to use grant funds to purchase 2 additional Area RAE units during their December 2010 meeting.

ALTERNATIVE FUEL VEHICLES TRAINING

Mr. Smoot advised that we hosted a successful course at the Akron General Health & Wellness Center in Bath January 25, 2011.

Ms. De Rose stated Montrose Ford supplied an alternative fueled vehicle for the course participants.

Mr. Smoot stated a thank you letter would be sent to Montrose Ford for supplying an alternative vehicle.

LEPC PLAN REVIEW

Mr. Smoot stated we received a concurrence for our submission of our LEPC Emergency Response and Preparedness Plan submitted for review in October 2010. He stated Ms. Bunting provided us with a few recommendations to improve the plan:

- Identification of our transportation hazards through a commodity flow study or broader hazards analysis
- Detailed evacuation plan routes

Ms. Bunting stated the transportation and the alternative evacuation routes are requirements. She stated the concurrence was given on the stipulation the transportation plan is updated up with scenarios and routes which will be used in the hazards analysis and to determine evacuation routes from those facilities. This information would be taken into consideration with the overall vulnerability zone and population

Ms. De Rose asked if that was specific to our Extremely Hazardous Substance (EHS) facilities.

Ms. Bunting replied affirmatively.

Mr. Miller stated these questions are currently on the EHS Hazards Analysis form and part of the interviewing process.

Ms. Bunting stated that they are not expecting this addition to be entirely complete for the next October 2011 submission but just a game plan of how we will achieve it over the next couple of years.

Mr. Smoot stated that this a project that Mr. Miller and himself would be working with Ms. Bunting to complete.

NEW BUSINESS

SPECIAL TEAMS PLANNER REPORT

Mr. Miller stated that the LEPC exercise is tentatively scheduled for May 14th, 2011 at Jones Chemical in New Franklin. Mr. Smoot and I had a meeting with Dan Casmey, Jones Chemical, early January 2011 to setup the exercise and get an idea of mutual objectives and goals. Since that time he stated Mr. Casmey has been extremely busy and they have exchanged phone calls but have not had much substance to moving forward with the exercise at this facility.

Ms. Abell asked if there was a hospital component to this exercise.

Mr. Miller replied that the objectives have not been determined yet. He stated that they are considering activating the EOC and maybe adding a hospital component to the exercise.

Ms. De Rose stated the LEPC should be added to the design team and suggested Ms. Abell serve on the team.

Ms. Abell replied affirmatively.

Mr. Miller stated we completed the team typing process; the Adobe software has been installed and the wireless card has been useful. He stated we are still waiting on the office furniture.

Mr. Miller stated he attended the Automated Critical Asset Management System (ACAMS) training with Mr. Smoot. Dave Winn, Ohio Department of Homeland Security (DHS), spoke about critical infrastructure and DHS database that we enter our county information into. Ms. De Rose is also trained on this system. He stated it is a lengthy process to enter a resource into the system.

Mr. Miller stated he needed a wireless mouse for his laptop and it should cost less than \$50.00.

Mayor Bollas made a motion to purchase a purchase a wireless computer mouse not to exceed \$50.00. Trustee Panovich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Ms. De Rose stated we need to open the floor for nominations to elect the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Second Vice Chairperson.

Ms. Abell nominated Clarence Tucker for Chairperson. Captain Groves seconded the motion.

Ms. De Rose inquired if there were any other nominations from the floor.

There were no other nominations from the floor.

Captain Groves made motion to close the nomination for Chairperson. Trustee Panovich seconded the motion.

Ms. De Rose stated we need nominations for the Vice Chairperson.

Ms. Abell nominated Sharen Breyer for Vice Chairperson. Captain Groves seconded the motion.

Ms. De Rose inquired if there were any other nominations from the floor.

There were no other nominations from the floor.

Mayor Bollas made motion to close the nomination for Vice Chairperson. Trustee Panovich seconded the motion.

Ms. De Rose stated we need nominations for the Second Vice Chairperson.

Ms. Breyer nominated Ginnie Abell for Second Vice Chairperson. Mayor Bollas seconded the motion.

Ms. De Rose inquired if there were any other nominations from the floor.

There were no other nominations from the floor.

Mayor Bollas made motion to close the nomination for Second Vice Chairperson. Mr. Weaver seconded the motion.

Ms. De Rose stated our new officers are Chairperson Clarence Tucker, Vice Chairperson Sharen Breyer and Second Vice Chairperson Ginnie Abell.

APPROVAL OF BUDGET

Mr. Smoot stated everyone should have received a copy of the budget.

Mr. Smoot stated we already have resolutions passed in 2010 for data input reimbursement for the University of Akron, \$8,400.00, and Akron Fire for \$4,200.00.

Ms. De Rose stated they need to send us an invoice for payment.

Captain Groves made a motion to approve the 2011 budget as listed. Trustee Panovich seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLANNER CONTRACT RENEWAL

Chairperson Tucker stated that earlier this week they renewed the Special Operations Response Team (SORT) portion of the Special Teams Planner contract which is up in March, 2010. He stated it has been a positive experience and beneficial.

Ms. De Rose stated that the majority of Chris's hours in the beginning were dedicated to SORT but now Chris is able to spend more time on LEPC activities. She stated our filings are coming in and he is completing the EHS facility reviews. Chris is balancing his task in addition to his other job and doing his job well.

Ms. Breyer stated Chris has taken the LEPC portion of this job to another level of professionalism, especially in documentation.

Chairperson Tucker asked Captain Groves for his opinion from the SORT Executive Board.

Captain Groves stated it is working very well and Chris is very systematic.

Captain Groves made a motion to renew the LEPC portion of the Special Teams Planner contract. Ms. Breyer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice.

INSTRUCTOR TECHNICIANS CONTRACT RENEWAL

Captain Groves gave a brief background on the Instructor Technicians contract with the University of Akron.

Ms. De Rose stated funds are still available in the previous contract and requested this item be tabled.

LEPC ALL-HAZARDS PLANNING CONFERENCE

Mr. Smoot stated we need to select a date for this year's conference.

Ms. Breyer stated we first need to check with the body to see if we want to have this conference this year.

Chairperson stated the information at these conferences has been a very worthwhile event. He stated we have had some excellent speakers present some very interesting

topics that were current and needed in the community. He stated great feedback has been received and we have increased our attendance.

Ms. Abell stated that May 19th or May 26th the auditorium and three pods have been reserved for our conference. If not in May were going to have to look at September.

There was discussion about May 19th being too close to the LEPC Exercise scheduled for May 14th, the upcoming holidays and the Domestic Preparedness Steering Committee retreat in September.

Ms. De Rose made a motion to not exceed \$8,000.00 to support the annual LEPC All-Hazards Planning Conference for May 19, 2011. Mr. Weaver seconded the motion.

Ms. Bunting stated a neighboring county began an industry users group at their conference and it has developed into regular meetings scheduled throughout the year. She suggested offering a breakout session for industry during the conference.

Ms. Breyer inquired if we could have them conduct a session during our conference and explain how their user group became so successful.

Ms. Bunting suggested we contact Don McDonald from the Stark County LEPC.

Captain Groves recommended Chief Vetter's, Ohio HazMat Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) 30 – 45 minute presentation on team typing throughout the state, the Cleveland Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) team and the 52nd WMD Civil Support Team from Columbus, OH.

Ms. Breyer recommended County Animals Rescue and Evacuation (CARE) as a conference speaker.

SUB-COMMITTEE REPORTS

EHS HAZARD ANALYSIS COMMITTEE

Captain Groves stated he has been working with Mr. Miller on the EHS interviews.

TRAINING, EDUCATION & EXERCISE COMMITTEE

Nothing new to report.

PLANNING COMMITTEE

Nothing new to report.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Ms. Breyer stated the training and travel budget is the largest part of the budget and we hope that we can do the same level of training or more this year. She said we should look at bringing speakers in to Summit County.

Chairperson Tucker recommended bringing a signup list to the next meeting.

INCIDENTS

Captain Groves briefly mentioned the ricin incident in Coventry Twp on January 28, 2011.

Mr. Brown passed out a list of all incidents reported to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in Summit County from January 1, 2010 to February 15, 2011. He suggested formulating a committee to check the Ohio EPA reporting against the LEPC to see who is not reporting to the LEPC.

Mr. Weaver volunteered to chair the Spill Report Compliance subcommittee. Mr. Brown, Captain Groves, Mr. Miller and Chairperson Tucker will also serve on this subcommittee.

Chairperson Tucker stated they have just had their typical diesel spills on the highway as well as assisting with Summit County HazMat in the ricin incident in Coventry Twp.

GOOD OF THE ORDER

Ms. De Rose suggested changing the time of the meeting to possibly the afternoon due to the Emergency Management Executive Committee (EMEC) meeting taking place at 10:00 am.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Weaver made a motion to adjourn; Ms. Breyer seconded the motion.

Being no further business to come before the Local Emergency Planning Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
