The Summit County Emergency Management Agency will host an **ICS-300 course**, a countywide course on **February 20-22, 2007 beginning at 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.** The course will be conducted at the **Akron Area Electrical JATC, 2650 South Main Street, Suite #100, Akron, OH 44319-1883.**

This 24-hour course expands on the basic ICS program, but does not repeat items covered in the Basic ICS course. More description and detail of the organization and operation of I.C.S. is provided, as well as the management of resources. The duties of all positions are described and examples are provided of how the essential principles are used in incident and event planning.

The target audience for the course is police, fire, health departments, hospitals and elected officials. **Students must have successfully completed IS-200.** (Ref: **NIMS Implementation Guide; www.ema.ohio.gov/NIMS asp**)
