What is ExecutiveMED?

ExecutiveMED is a prescription discount card intended to help Summit County citizens cope with the high price of prescription medications.

Who can use the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card?

All Summit County citizens, regardless of age, income, or existing health coverage, may use the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card.

How can I obtain an ExecutiveMED prescription discount card?

The ExecutiveMED prescription discount card is available at various community organizations and government offices throughout the county. To have an ExecutiveMED prescription discount card mailed to your home call 1-888-456-EXEC (3932).

What pharmacies accept the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card?

The ExecutiveMED prescription discount card is accepted at over 57,000 participating retail pharmacies in the Caremark network, including many of today's leading pharmacies.

What type of savings does the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card provide?

The ExecutiveMED prescription discount card is projected to save Summit County citizens an average of 20 percent off the regular retail price of prescription medications. Prices sometimes vary from pharmacy to pharmacy. If the sale price of a certain medication is lower than the ExecutiveMED discounted price, you will pay the sale price.

What type of savings does the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card provide for mail service prescriptions?

The ExecutiveMED prescription discount card is projected to save Summit County citizens an average of 50 percent off the regular retail price of a 90-day supply of select generic medicines.

Does the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card work in conjunction with any other type of prescription drug coverage?

No, the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card cannot be used in conjunction with any other type of prescription drug card. However, citizens may use the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card to purchase prescription medicine not covered by their insurance.

If I purchase over-the-counter medications, will I be able to use my ExecutiveMED prescription discount card?

No, the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card does not offer savings on over-the-counter medications. However, discounts are available for many diabetic supplies.

How much does the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card cost?

The ExecutiveMED prescription discount card is FREE to all Summit County citizens.

How is the County of Summit able to offer the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card to citizens?

Working with Caremark allows the County of Summit to offer the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card program to citizens. The program was developed at no cost to the county, but time used in preparation and production.

Are there any limits on the number of times that the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card can be used?

No, there are no limits on the number of times a citizen may use an ExecutiveMED prescription discount card.

Does the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card work outside the County of Summit?

Yes, the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card can be used outside the County of Summit. In fact, 8 out of 10 pharmacies nationwide accept ExecutiveMED.

Do other communities provide prescription discount card programs to citizens?

Over 300 local governments across the country offer prescription discount cards to citizens. The County of Summit is the second county in the State of Ohio to provide this unique service to citizens.

How do I activate my ExecutiveMED prescription discount card?

To activate the ExecutiveMED prescription discount card you must present your card at any participating retail pharmacy. There is no enrollment form, no membership fee and your card is available for immediate use.

Does everyone in my family need to have his or her own ExecutiveMED card?

No, an entire family can use the same ExecutiveMED card if preferred.
