On Friday, July 13, 2007, Russell M. Pry was sworn in as Summit County Executive by the Honorable Domestic Relations Court Judge Carol J. Dezso.

Russ Pry’s elected official background includes serving as a Village of Mogadore Councilman. While, his professional career consists of working as an attorney with the law firm, Cassetty, Muse & Pry, serving as the law director for the Village of Boston Heights, as chairman of the Democratic Party of Summit County and as a board member with the Summit County Board of Elections and the Akron-Summit County Public Library.

The primary function of Summit County Executive is to serve, among other duties, as chief budgetary officer of county government, submitting a yearly operating budget and overseeing the expenditures in excess of a billion dollars annually, which are channeled through various offices, departments and programs within the governmental branch.
