District 8 Integrating Committee Approves Program Year 24 Project List

The District 8 Public Works Integrating Committee approved the Program Year 24 project list for the State Capital Improvement Program (formerly Issue 2) and Local Transportation Improvement Program at its November 17, 2009 meeting. The Committee approved a list of 13 projects, totaling nearly \$14.3 million in grants and loans for infrastructure improvements in Summit County. The project list will be forwarded to the Ohio Public Works Commission, and disbursement of funds will begin July 1, 2010. Below is the approved project list for Program Year 24.
