Summit County Executive Russell M. Pry Promotes Patricia Divoky

Today, Wednesday, June 23, 2010, County Executive Russell M. Pry named Patricia Divoky as the Director of the Summit County Department of Job and Family Service (DJFS). The position requires managing a \$68 million budget and the supervision of nearly 400 staff members.



For the past 10 months, Divoky had been functioning as the Interim Director of the agency.

“Pat Divoky has done an exceptional job during her tenure with Job and Family Services,” said County Executive Russ Pry. “I look forward to working with her as she moves the agency forward.”

Since joining the County of Summit, in March 2002, Divoky has served the Department of Job and Family Services as the Deputy Director of the Division of Children and Adult Services and the Assistant Director of Programs.

Prior to her arrival, Divoky served eight years as the Executive Director for the Greater Cleveland Nurses' Association, 12 years as an adjunct faculty member at Cleveland State University, a term as a City of Highland Heights Council Member and time as a private sector business consultant.

Patricia holds a master of business administration degree from Cleveland State University and a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from Kent State University.
