Project	Description	Estimated Cost
Jail Lighting Upgrade Project	Replace existing fluorescent fixtures with magnetic ballasts and T-12 lamps with electronic ballasts and T-8 lamps. Replace exit lights with LED lamps and incandescent with fluorescent lamps	\$200,000
Ohio Building Window Replacement Project	Replace leaking inefficient windows with high efficiency windows	\$350,000
Medical Examiners Roof Replacement Project	Replace leaking modified bitumen roof with new white TPO roof	\$100,000
Courthouse Lighting Upgrade Project	Replace inefficient high wattage indirect lights with energy efficient fluorescent lights	\$220,000
Safety Building Window Upgrade Project	Replace leaking inefficient windows with high efficiency windows; add insulation above ceiling where required.	\$310,000
Parking Deck Lighting Project	Replace existing lighting with new LED and fluorescent with photo cell control.	\$200,000
Energy Audits	Perform energy audits on the low scoring buildings. Look for energy savings opportunities in lighting, HVAC and building envelope. Buildings include the Jail, Medical Examiner, Safety Building, Courthouse, Ohio Building and Sheriff Training Facility	\$150,000
Small Projects Fund	Allowance for miscellaneous small projects such as installing submeters and motion sensors, relocating thermostats, relighting etc.	\$168,800
Summit County Revolving Loan Fund	Loan program to provide funding to Summit County for-profit businesses for energy efficiency retrofits and improvements.	\$500,000
SC EECBG Communities and Non-Profit Organization Grants	Matching grant program to provide funding to Summit County communities and non-profits for energy efficiency retrofits and improvements.	\$500,000
