The project consists of all efforts required for the following general items of work:

1) Install approximately 840 LF of 10" diameter HDPE force main and air release assembly along Warner Road in Akron, Ohio.

2) Replacement and/or Rehabilitation of approximately 2274 LF of 24" diameter sanitary sewer and 10 manholes along Warner Road.

Contract award will be based upon determination of the lowest and best bid for the specific project option selected for construction by the County.
