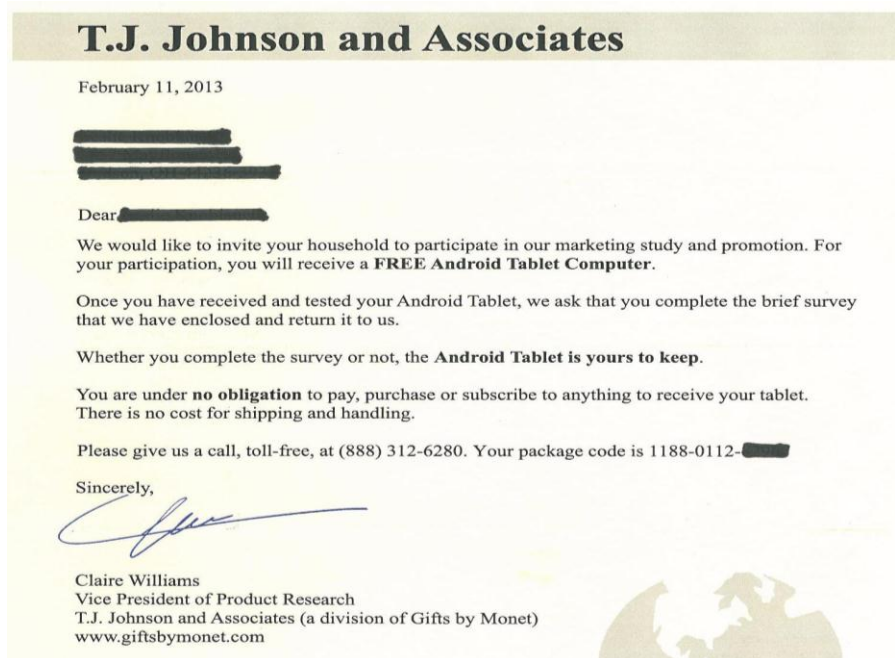

ALERT!

One of my employees received the letter below to participate in a marketing study and receive a FREE Android Tablet Computer:



While researching what sounded like a great offer, she found several reports on trusted sites (e.g. Scambook.com, RipOffReport.com and bbb.org) denouncing this as a scam. According to those reports, you must call a toll-free number to receive the tablet. That is where the Better Business Bureau says the problem begins.

This is actually an attempt to lure you into purchasing a vacation package. Some commenters stated the company even requested a copy of their W-9.

Never give personal information over the phone or by mail or email. Always check out the company's validity with the Better Business Bureau.

The old saying is true, "If it sounds too good to be true, it probably IS."
