ALERT!

One of my employees received the below email supposedly from the Postal Service:



Since he was expecting a package from Federal Express and it looked legitimate to him, he opened the “Get & Print Receipt” link. His spyware immediately popped up with a virus warning.

Even if you are expecting an overnight package, the carrier will leave a note on your door. Avoid opening any emails from parcel carriers and banks, and never open an email claiming you have won a large amount of money. These are very common scams. Software is even available to criminals so they can copy website pages of banks, postal services, etc.
