### **Man going to jail for not paying child support**

(January 23, 2008, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced that on January 23, 2008, Judge Shapiro sentenced DANIEL M. HOLDERFIELD to thirty days in the Summit County Jail for the crime of nonsupport of dependents. At the time of sentencing, the defendant owed \$52,352.44 in child support arrears.

This criminal nonsupport case involves three children. In 1998, the Summit County Child Support Enforcement Agency issued an administrative child support order in the amount of \$214.70 monthly per child.

Defendant failed to meet his financial obligation to his children and was charged with criminal nonsupport in 2004. In September 2004, Defendant pled guilty to one count of nonsupport, a felony of the fifth degree and was sentenced to five years of community control.

On January 23, 2008, the defendant pled guilty to violating the terms and conditions of his probation and was sentenced to thirty days in jail.
