Recent headlines in the news highlight my concerns for our older citizens. A man has been arrested in the February 25, 2008 attack on an elderly couple, stabbing to death an 81-year-old man and wounding his wife.

Two local men were robbed in separate incidents after they opened the door to a stranger who was asking if he could plow their driveway. Instead, he pushed the two elderly men down and stole their wallets.

*Remember:*

Do not open your door to strangers *any time*, even during the day.

Let go of your property. It is not worth bodily harm.

Trust your instincts.

Keep an eye out for each other.

Be alert to your surroundings.

Keep your doors locked at *all* times.
