ALERT!

The Macedonia Police Department reported recently that a woman received a call three times from an unknown person claiming she won \$10.5 million in a Wal-Mart lottery.

The caller instructed her to go to Wal-Mart and purchase a \$900 Greendot Money Card. The purchase amounted to approximately 1% of the alleged \$10.5 million lottery winnings. She was then instructed to call a phone number to receive an address to mail the Greendot Card and that the card would be mailed back, along with the lottery winnings credited to it. The caller said she was to reference #L6P3 and ask for Kurt Charles Clarkson.

This is a scam!

If you have caller I.D., do not answer your phone if you don't recognize the caller. If you answer a call that you suspect is fraudulent, hang up and call your local police department to report the call so they can immediately send out an advisory.
